Question(s):

1. I was wondering what the call volume is and if we have wreck vs impound vs breakdown as well as how many are passenger cars vs semis.
2. Is there going to be a need for the forensic building at our shop. We can definitely accommodate that but didn't see anything in the packet about it.

Answer:

In 2023 the Sheriff's Office reported 517 collisions that involved one or more vehicles being towed. 390 crashed vehicles were taken to the tow vendor's yard.

In 2023 the Sheriff's Office reported 9 collisions involving heavy trucks that resulted in one or more vehicles being towed.

The numbers above do not account for tows conducted by a someone other than the County vendor, although that number is very small.

In 2023 the Sheriff's Office towed 365 vehicles for reasons other than traffic crashes. Those reasons included impoundment, hazards, and abandoned.

Additionally, the Sheriff's Office routinely calls upon the vendor as a courtesy to the motoring public when a vehicle is disabled. This often involves a tow or service that is not tracked by our Office and thus not reflected in the statistics shown above.

The Sheriff's Office will not require use of a forensics building, only secure indoor storage as specified in the RFP.
